WOULDHAM PARISH COUNCIL VILLAGE HALL COMMITTEE

TERMS OF REFERENCE

Approved by Wouldham Parish Council on 2nd July 2019

1. MEMBERSHIP

- 1.1 The Committee shall consist of **3** Parish Councillors, one of whom will be the Chairman of the Parish Council, who shall be elected each year at the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council.
- 1.2 Existing Committee members are eligible for re-election.
- 1.3 The Committee may, at its discretion, invite non- Councillors whose expertise and knowledge will be beneficial to Committee deliberations.
- 1.4 The Committee, shall at its first meeting after the Council's Annual General Meeting, elect a Chairman. It may, at that or any other time, elect a Vice Chairman.
- 1.5 Both the Chairman and Vice Chairman may stand for re-election.

2. FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS

2.1 The Committee will meet at least twice a year, with additional meeting when required.

3. VOTING

- 3.1 The quorum for a meeting will be a minimum of three councillor members
- 3.2 All decisions of the committee shall be determined by majority vote. The Chairman has the casting vote when there are equal numbers of votes

4. **PROCEDURES**

4.1 Any governing Document submitted by the Village Hall Committee is to be approved by Wouldham Parish Council.

4.2 The Committee will operate according to its Charity Status.

4.3 The Committee may submit a budget to the Council as part of the Council's overall budget process.

4.4 The Committee Chairman will report to the Council at its monthly meetings

5. **RIGHTS AND POWERS**

5.1 The Committee will have delegated powers to:

- 5.1.1 Plan for the ongoing development of the Village Hall, making recommendations to the Parish Council as appropriate
- 5.1.2 Determine the terms and conditions of use of the facilities
- 5.1.3 Determine the fees relating to the hire of the facilities
- 5.2 The Committee has the right to:
 - 5.2.1 Appoint Steering Groups to facilitate the work of the Committee

6. **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 6.1 Ensure that regular risk assessments and health and safety checks are made in line with current legislation
- 6.2 Ensure the provision of safe and well maintained facilities for the community use.
